Penryn School 2013-14 Classroom Supply List

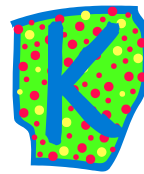
KINDERGARTEN:

Items to be labeled with your child's name:

- 1 backpack-No rolling types
- 1 lunchbox/bag

Items to be shared and do not need to be labeled:

- 1-1 ½ inch binder with clear view front...to be returned to you at the end of the year
- 25 or so clear sheet protectors
- 6-12 black, skinny whiteboard markers
- 6-12 glue sticks
- 2 Black Sharpie pens
- 4 Packages baby wipes
- Boys- 1 box of re-sealable sandwich bags
- Girls -1 box of re-sealable gallon bags



Items provided by the teacher:

- Homework folder
- Dry erase boards and erasers
- Pencils
- Crayons
- Markers

FIRST GRADE:

- Boys- 1 box of resealable sandwich bags
- Girls- 1 box of resealable gallon bags
- 1 8 or 10 pack broad tip colored markers
- 2 boxes Crayola crayons
- 10 or more glue sticks
- 2 – sets Dry Erase Markers (broad or wide tip)
- 3 plain pocket folders: 1 red, 1 blue and 1 yellow (make sure the folder has two pockets inside)
- 1 package baby wipes



Every first grader is expected to bring a backpack (without wheels) to school everyday.

SECOND GRADE:

- A pencil box
- Package of colored pencils and or skinny markers
- Box of crayons
- White board markers and an old sock (used as an eraser)
- 1 Two pocket folder (Can be one with a picture)
- 2 glue sticks
- #2 pencils (sharpened)
- Pink erasers (pencil top or stick)
- A backpack or bag for transporting items
- 2 1"binders
- 1 package of printer paper



- Boys: 1 box of resealable gallon bags
- Girls: 1 box of resealable sandwich bags
- 1 plain yellow two pocket folder

Optional for classroom use
Astrobright photocopy paper
Black sharpies
Colored sharpies

THIRD GRADE: Your child will not need any kind of binder

Individual items to be kept in desk:

- 1 small pencil box or pouch to hold colored pencils, markers
- 1 plastic (can be paper if you can't find plastic) orange folder with pockets, **no brads**
- 1 blue folder with pockets, **with brads** to hold papers
- 1 colored folder, your choice, with brads for papers
- 1 set colored pencils (dozen size)
- 1 set fine (skinny ones) markers (small set, 8 or less)
- 1 small pencil sharpener for colored pencils that holds shavings

Items to be shared with table partners:

- 1 big pink eraser
- 12 Ticonderoga pencils, #2 lead, sharpened (please)
This is the only brand these days that you can sharpen with an electric sharpener....the others just break
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 highlighters
- Set of dry eraser markers (NOT yellow, it doesn't show)
- 1 dry erase marker eraser



Other items we could really use:

- white **index** copy paper
- Sharpie pens: colored, regular tip
- Sharpie pens: black, fine tipped
- Astro Bright copy paper
- Gallon and sandwich sized ziplock bags
- colored felt squares
- white Crayola Model Magic (air dry clay)

FOURTH GRADE:

- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pencil box
- 1 set each of one or more of the following: markers **or** crayons (can be twistable), **or** Colored pencils
- 4 white-board markers (Low odor)
- 1 pencil sharpener (No motors please)
- 2 glue sticks
- 4 #2 pencils
- 4 pencil top erasers
- 2 black sharpie pens (Fine tip)
- 2 highlighters
- 1 ream of white copy paper
- 1 tube Elmers clear gel glue
- 1 wash cloth to be used as a whiteboard eraser



Teacher will provide the following:

- 6 Colored subject folders
- Ruler, Dry erase board, and eraser
- Post-it notes

FIFTH GRADE:

Items to be stored in student desks: (Please keep in mind that desk space is limited.)

- 4 pocket folder
- 1 – 1 inch binder
- Cloth for erasing white boards
